**Saturday, September 17<sup>th</sup> - Slichot :**

In-Person only service at 7:00 p.m.

**Sunday, September 25<sup>th</sup> - Erev Rosh Hashanah :**

Potluck Dinner at Temple Bnai Israel at 6:30 p.m.

Evening Service begins at 7:30 p.m.

**Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup> - First Day Rosh Hashanah :**

Morning Service begins at 10:00 a.m. and concludes ~12:00 p.m.

Tashlich in person at Lauter Park immediately following kiddush, weather permitting.

**Tuesday, September 27<sup>th</sup> - Second Day Rosh Hashanah :** Morning Service begins at 10:00 a.m. and concludes ~12:00 p.m.

**Sunday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> - Cemetery Service :**

Begins at 1:00 p.m. In this season when we face our own mortality and our relationship with the living God, we honor the lives of our community's loved ones with this brief memorial service.

**Tuesday, October 4<sup>th</sup> - Kol Nidrei :**

Begins promptly at 6:00 p.m.

**Wednesday, October 5<sup>th</sup> - Yom Kippur :**

Morning Service begins at 10:00 a.m. and concludes ~12:00 p.m.

**Yizkor Evening Service :**

Begins at 6:00 p.m. If you wish, please have a picture of the loved ones you are remembering to share on a table in the sanctuary or through your webcam.

**Yom Kippur Conclusion :**

Ne'ilah begins ~6:30 p.m., with the Final Shofar, Havdalah & Break-fast at ~7:05 p.m.

**In-Person Event Attendance Policy:** Attendance at all Temple events requires all individuals over 6 months old must be fully vaccinated and provide evidence of vaccination (either ahead of time or at the door); all participants must be masked when not eating or drinking.
